Generating Demand for Effective Implementation of MVA Act 2019



Committee Meeting on 'Generating demand for effective implementation of Motor Vehicle Amendment 2019', was held at Chittorgarh on April 25, 2022. CP Joshi, Member of Parliament, was the chief guest who opined that road users, lawmakers and law enforcers should work together to maintain road safety and management.

Jagdish Bairwa, RTO, while delivering the keynote address, stated that these new amendments are comprehensive and progressive. He mentioned that the entire licencing system had been made online to get a valid licence. Rajeev Joshi, DSP (Traffic), the Indian roads are unique. As it sees a heterogenous mix of vehicles and

pedestrians, which requires an extraordinary form of management, he also shared his experiences of the kind of responses he got from the traffic violators, especially helmets, seatbelts and jumping traffic lights.

Manish Sharma, District Transport Officer, highlighted the need to make officials aware of the rules and notifications of the Act. Madhu Sudan Sharma, CUTS, made a presentation on MVA Act 2019, its opportunities, challenges and the way forward. Gauhar Mehmood shared the objectives and Satyapal Singh and Madan Giri Goswami gave a vote of thanks. Over 85 stakeholder representatives participated in the event.

From Organic to Chemical-Free Farming in Rajasthan



With the support of the Swedish Society for Nature Conservation, CUTS implemented a project named "Developing a Culture of Sustainable Consumption and Lifestyle Through Promoting Organic Consumption and

Production and Adopting Sustainable C on sumption Practices by Engaging Consumers in the State of Rajasthan, India" (ProScop). This

project will be implemented in 12 targeted districts and all seven divisions of Rajasthan for five years (2022-2026).

Gram Panchayat/Village-level Awareness Workshops were held in Chittorgarh, Bhilwara, Banswara and Pratpagarh districts of Rajasthan. The resource person discussed the importance of organic farming, the harmful effects of chemical-based farming and plastic use, and linkages with agricultural promotional schemes. A documentary on organic farming and sustainable practices was shown. A total of 445 farmers attended eight events.

Combating Child Labour in Rajasthan

Cuts, in partnership with World Vision India (WVI) and Vagdhara, has implemented a project entitled 'Strengthening Formal and Informal Systems and Structures as well as the Capacities of Vulnerable Children and Households to Reduce Child Labour in Banswara and Pratapgarh, Rajasthan.'

The project's objective is to reduce the incidences of harmful child labour by 50 percent by 2025 in the Suhagpura block of Pratapgarh district and Ghatol block of Banswara district of Rajasthan.



A training programme for Faith Leaders was held May 11-12, 2022. Four contents were covered with performing activities and games:

- 1. Addressing the past (my hope and dream for my family, most memorable childhood experience, signs of wholeness, brokenness and goodness);
- 2. Recognising the present (joy and pains, space for love and grace, reason for thanksgiving and opportunity for forgiveness);
- 3. Envisioning the future (defining moments, wise builders, determining our steps); and
- 4. Pursuing our dreams (engraved on the palms of hands, speaking blessings).



Farmers' Formation and Promotion

CUTS undertook Farmers Producer Organisations (FPOs) project with the support from the Small Farmers Agribusiness Consortium (SFAC), National Bank for Agricultural and Rural Development (NABARD), and National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) in Bharatpur, Chittorgarh and Banswara districts of Rajasthan. The aim is to facilitate sustainable income-oriented farming development, productivity, and effective capacity building to develop agriculture entrepreneurship skills.

Training of Board of Directors (BoDs) and Chief Executive Officers (CEOs) was held in the Pratapgarh district of Rajasthan. Mahender

Dudi, District Development Manager NABARD, Madan Giri Goswami and Mohanlal Meghwal were the main resource persons. They delivered sessions on the importance of FPOs for small and marginal farmers, roles and responsibilities of CEOs and BoDs, statutory compliances, agriculture promotion schemes, etc. In open discussion, participants raised concerns about FPOs promotion and challenges.

Consumer Awareness Programmes

Consumer Awareness Programmes were held in collaboration with the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) Jaipur at Chittorgarh on April 20, 2022, and at Bhilwara on April 21, 2022, respectively. The objective was to raise awareness of the Indian Standards Institute (ISI), Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) or other certifications.



Representatives from Self Help Group, Farmers

Producers Organisations, Retailers, Food inspector, District Supply Office, Dinesh Bhatnagar, ICDS, Neetu Joshi, Women Support Centre, Advocate Chandmal Garg, Disabled People Organisation, Students, Non-governmental Organisations, Community-based Organisations participated in Chittorgarh.

Prahlad Ray Vyas, Secretary, Consumer Rights Committee, and Suman Trivedi, Judicial Member, Permanent Lok Adalat, and Rajendra Meena, Officer BIS Jaipur, were resource persons of the programme in Bhilwara. A total of 118 consumers attended both events.

Life Skills Education for Transformation

Three-day training on 'Life Skills Education for Transformation' was organised by World Vision India in collaboration with CUTS and Vaagdhara at Pratapgarh. The objective of the training was to create master trainers in LSET at the village level who will work continuously with the children and support them in learning life skills education.

The training sessions were full of enjoyment and games/activities. S Francis (Technical Specialist, Child Protection) facilitated the training. A total of 14 volunteers and project staff attended the training.

Asha Kiran- A Ray of Hope

With the support of the Rotary India Literacy Mission, CUTS CHD undertook a project entitled 'Asha Kiran- A Ray of Hope (A programme to send children back to school). 10 teachers were appointed and trained by Rotary India Literacy Mission to send back 400 children to schools from socially and economically disadvantaged and vulnerable communities.



A Parent's Workshop was organised on June 14, 2022. The objective was to initiate a discussion with parents to ensure regular education of their children; give good education to their children at home; and how they can teach their children small concepts from household items when they are illiterate. A total of 50 parents attended.

National Panchayati Raj Day Observed

National Panchayati Raj Day was observed at *Gram Panchayat*, Nahargarh, Chittorgarh, on April 24, 2022. The aim was to recognise *panchayats* as a system of self-governance, wherein the *panchayats* are responsible for delivering justice and ensuring the development of their villages.

The Day was celebrated in honour of the 73rd Constitutional Amendment Act in 1992; the representative shared the roles, responsibilities,



achievements, concerns, and resolutions about panchayats. More than 32 people attended the event.

Commemorating World Day Against Child Labour

orld Day Against Child Labour was commemorated at Chittorgarh on June 12, 2022. Media personnel visited the field intervention area and asked the children, community persons, village-level Child Protection Committee members, and Programme Coordinator to discuss the root causes of child labour and the steps to curb it. The discussion was well covered in the media. On this Day, a rally was organised to promote awareness of child labour,



responsibility, and encouragement among children through various sports and games.

Another event was observed at *Kachi Basti Jodhras* to raise awareness of child labour and beggary issues. Parents were requested not to involve their children in labour and beggary and ask them to send their children to school regularly. A total of 40 children attended the event.

Celebrating World Environment Day

orld Environment Day was organised at Limbodi and Kataro ka Kheda villages of Pratapgarh district of Rajasthan on June 05, 2022. On the occasion, children planted saplings to impart two powerful messages about child labour-free India and the importance of planting trees. 65 children out of 10 children groups participated and made the event successful.
