#### **Digital Generation, Our Generation**

National Girl Child Day was observed in the Bhilwara district of Rajasthan on January 24, 2023. National Girl Child Day is celebrated across the country to promote awareness about the rights of the girl child to bridge the gender divide and to lay emphasis on the importance of girls' education, health and nutrition. The slogan for the National Girl Child Day 2023 is "Digital Generation, Our Generation."

#### **Formation and Promotion of FPOs**

CUTS undertook Farmers Producer Organisation (FPO) project with support from the Small Farmers Agribusiness Consortium (SFAC), National Bank for Agricultural and Rural Development (NABARD), and National Cooperative

Development Corporation (NCDC) to form and promote 34 FPOs in Pratapgarh, Bharatpur, Bhilwara Chittorgarh and Banswara districts of Rajasthan.

The project aims to facilitate sustainable, income-oriented farming development, increase productivity, realise higher returns, establish market linkages, effectively build capacity to develop agriculture entrepreneurship skills and create self-sustaining outcomes. A total of 25,000 farmers will directly benefit from the project.



#### **Fairs to Promote Organic Way of Life**

Organic Produce Fairs were held in Banswara on January 10, 2023; in Pratapgarh on February 19, 2023; and in Chittorgarh on February 28, 2023. The progressive farmers displayed their organic produce in outlets. The purpose of the fairs was to guide farmers about organic farming modes and make consumers aware of the available organic products and their benefits by bringing them both on the same platform.

These fairs will help consumers and farmers to connect for the sale and purchase of products. Deputy Directors of Agriculture, Horticulture, ATMA, and KVK were resource persons. About 1000 persons witnessed these three events.

#### **Time to Send Children Back to School**

Send Children Back to School Programme educates 400 eligible children through 10 Asha Kiran Centres in slum and underprivileged areas. These children drop out of school regularly, coming from socially and economically disadvantaged and vulnerable communities, such as the children of migrant workers, victims of child labour practices, and children in need of care and protection.

The aim is to send these children back to formal government and government-aided schools, provide educational materials to students, orient and train 10 Asha Kiran teachers to provide quality education and conduct monitoring visits in all Asha Kiran Centres.

#### **Safer Roads for All!**

District Level Consultation on Road Safety was held at Pratapgarh and Banswara districts of Rajasthan on January 16-17, 2023 respectively. The theme of National Road Safety Week 2023 was 'Parvah Karenge Surakshit Rahenge' to promote the cause of safer roads for all.

CP Joshi, Member of Parliament, Chittorgarh; Ramesh Kumar Meena, Pradhan; Deputy Director of Information Technology and Information Department; Traffic Inspector, Assistant District Education Officer; Assistant Professor, PG College; Assistant Engineer Public Works Department; Inspector, District Transport Department; and Auto and Bus Associations were speakers and guests. They stated that road accident deaths in India are among the highest in the world.



Needless to say, pedestrians, motorcyclists and bicyclists are among the least protected, hence two-wheeler and four-wheeler drivers must wear helmets and seatbelts while driving. With the goal of reducing the number of accidents due to speeding, potholes, carelessness, and drunk driving, road safety norms should be followed. A total of 305 people attended the event.

#### **Schools Teaching Organic Gardening**

Organic gardens were established in schools of Chittorgarh, Pratapgarh, Bhilwara and Banswara districts of Rajasthan. The aim is to teach a culture of sustainable consumption and bring the campaign of organic farming to the children's level. Organic clubs and gardens are being developed in each district. An Organic Club comprising 25-30 children was formed to develop organic gardens. If organic gardens are developed in these schools, then the grown vegetables will be used for mid-day meal schemes (MDMs), with the help of teachers to address nutrition and environmental issues.
