One day Orientation Workshop of SHGs leaders organised in collaboration with National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) held on 14 August 2018 at Gram Panchyat meeting hall Bassi, Chittorgarh. The objective of this Workshop is to enhance the capacity of the SHG leaders/Representative through modular training in leadership, team building and focus on Enterprise Development Training.
